Application

Funds raised through Columbia-Greene 4-H fundraising activities, including the GCYF 4-H Ice Cream Stand and the Columbia County Fair 4-H Milk Bar, are earmarked to provide up to three \$250 scholarships for college-bound 4-H members.

The scholarship is available to any current Columbia-Greene 4-H member who will be attending college next year. The scholarship may be received once.

To apply provide the following information on a separate paper and return it to the Linda Tripp by March 25, 2019 – <u>Lke2@cornell.edu</u> or CCE, 479 Rt. 66, Hudson, NY 12534. Also include a current photo (senior or head shot) – you can scan and email or provide hard copy.

- 1. Your name, mailing address, email address and phone number.
- 2. The full names of your parents.
- 3. The name of the school you are currently attending.
- 4. The college you plan to attend with the area of study. If you have not chosen one yet, provide those at which you have been accepted.
- 5. Describe the various 4-H projects that were most meaningful to you and the extent of your involvement in them. Numbers and dates are helpful.
- 6. Tell about 4-H leadership roles and county/state activities you have been involved in. Again, numbers and dates are helpful.
- 7. Explain what you have gained most from your experiences in 4-H and how they will help you in the future.
